"I'm writing more...But it can't fix all my problems...I really wish I could fly.




"Key" by Mox is a very special track.






Figure 1 lists the top 10 BPP characters's total BPP appearances along with the proportion of which are first panel appearances.


With a few notable exceptions, most BPP characters have mostly similar ratios of first panel/total apperances.

Ball, Saya, and Marshal boast much higher ratios of first panel usage; unsuprisingly, they are the BPPSonas of the 3 most active BPP artists, who participate in more "smaller" BPPs which have fewer followup pages.

Some BPP characters have notably low first panel ratios, including Scarecrow, Bodhi, Crewmate, and Smokev.

Bodhi and Crewmate are the two non-bppsona characters; thev frequently appear as background gags. Smokey has seen very consistent usage in recent larger BPPs, which naturally allow for more followup pages.

Scarecrow is interesting, as despite a comparitvely "late" introduction compared to other BPPsonas, he is extremely easy to draw and comedically versatile.

Ragu is technically the first BPP signed by Shoji, he technically character; when viewing BPP1, he is not associated with any parappears in panel 1 book 1!


Ragu has broadly fluxuating usage; while this data was not mon background gag character, collected, I hypothesise a correlation with the presence of his landscape and scene panels via corresponding artist.



Since BPP#53, Bodhi has averaged a 5% appearance rate.

Bodhi sees consistent but low usage, outside of a few outlying spikes. While originally deticular artist.

Bodhi is an extremely comreferenced in a large number of his infinite high top.



Crewmate technically refers to a number of characters, including Amon and Greene as seen in the original joke popularity contest panels. Crewmates were very frequently used especially in earlier BPPs, being simple to draw even for less talented artists. However. Crewmates have dropped in popularity overtime.

This is likely due to the introduction of Scarecrow, who not only is a full BPPsona, but fufills a similar niche in being an extremely simple design, with the added benefit of suitabiltiy for an "antagonistic" character role.

In short, Scarecrow is the new Among Us.
